

Important Information for Exhibitors and Stand Constructors

We would like to ask you to carefully read through the following information in order to facilitate the installation and use of a WiFi at DMEXCO in accordance with your individual requirements. We would particularly like to ask you to forward this information to the person in charge of your stand's IT so that we can respond to your personal requirements for optimal WiFi operation as soon as possible.

Important note:

Current WiFis operate in the 2.4 GHz and 5 GHz bands. As a result of the increasing number of users of the 5Ghz band, the WiFi (802.11a/n/ac) capacity available here is becoming increasingly limited.

In order to avoid interference with the operation of your own WiFi and the WiFi of other exhibitors as far as possible, it is necessary to coordinate the WiFi networks centrally. As is specified in the Special Conditions for Participation (Point 12), it is not permissible to operate an individually owned WiFi network or router!

Therefore, if you plan to use data services at your expo stand you can book an Internet connection at the Koelnmesse Service Portal or directly through NetCologne. This connection already includes a preconfigured 5GHz WiFi access point.

Please note the following:

- Please make sure that your WiFi devices support 5GHz WiFi (802.11a/n/ac). (5GHz-capable devices are identified with an "a" in the description at 802.11 abgn/agn/an). Noncompatible devices may be upgraded with an external WiFi adapter.
- For stands measuring approximately 100 square meters or more, it may be necessary to install additional WiFi transmitters. **Please contact us as soon as possible** so that we can cooperate with you to find a solution that fits your requirements.
- To arrange adjustments/special features or configuration wishes, please get in touch as soon as possible with the service provider NetCologne.

Please keep in mind that we can only provide support for terminals using 5 GHz WiFi.

In terms of reliability, radio transmission is not a replacement for a cable connection. We therefore recommend that all installed workplaces should be equipped with network connections whether or not they are using the Koelnmesse/NetCologne WiFi router. Taking this into account when planning your expo stand will enable a flexible reaction at a later time if necessary.
